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Terms and Conditions

- 1) The parents or legal guardians of the player listed on this registration form agree to waive, release, absolve, and hold harmless Babe Ruth Baseball, Inc., DBRL and its organizers, sponsors, managers, coaches, and persons transporting the player to/from DBRL activities from and against every cause of action or claim arising out of an injury to the player, whether said injury occurs as the result of negligence or any other cause.
- 2) Registration fees are non-refundable. Exceptions (severe injury, moving out of town ...) will be considered only if a written request is submitted to the President prior to the start of the regular season.
- 3) All equipment and tournament team uniforms issued to the player must be returned at the conclusion of the season in reasonably same condition (except normal wear and tear). The parent or legal guardian agrees to compensate DBRL for lost or damaged equipment or uniforms issued to the player.
- 4) Players exhibiting gross misconduct will be immediately removed from the game and, depending on the severity, will be subject to suspension and possible expulsion from DBRL. Examples of gross misconduct include (but are not limited to): fighting, intentional acts of harm, obscene language or gestures, gross or lewd behavior, and threats.
- 5) The parents or legal guardians of the player listed on this registration are expected to conform to a strict code of conduct at all DBRL events. Verbal abuse of umpires, managers, coaches, league officials, opposing players, or other spectators is strictly prohibited. Physical confrontations, lewd or inappropriate language/gestures, and other aggressive behavior will not be tolerated. Violators will be asked by the umpire or a league official to leave the ball park and the incident will be referred to the board of directors for further possible action, including banishment from future games. Refusal to leave the playing area may result in the player's removal from the game or forfeit.
- 6) The parents or legal guardians of the player agree that questions or issues to be discussed with a manager or coach will take place in a discreet fashion away from the ball field after a game/practice.
- 7) The parents or legal guardians of the player acknowledge that participation in DBRL may result in serious injury and that protective equipment does not prevent all injuries to players.
- 8) The parents and legal guardians of the player further agree that DBRL may, in its sole discretion, limit participation of the above named player in the program due to physical, emotional, un-sportsman like behavior or mental disabilities or injury that may be potentially harmful to him or to other participants.
